

## **Mount Vernon Township – Minutes**

Regular Meeting – October 28, 2024 – 4:00 P.M.  
Town Hall – 811 Harrison Street, Mount Vernon, Illinois

The regularly scheduled monthly meeting of Mount Vernon Township was called to order by Supervisor Amanda Bean at 4:02 p.m.

Township elected officials present were Supervisor Amanda Bean, Road Commissioner Kenny Hayes, Clerk Nick LeMay, Trustees Chris Braden and Korey Stover. Those absent were Trustees Charlie Heck and Lyle Hicks as well as Assessor Kip Bauer.

Correspondence: Supervisor Bean reported that the first installment of real estate taxes has been deposited by Jefferson County Treasurer's office.

Bean also stated that Hopewell Cemetery has contributed \$500 to the Mount Vernon Township mowing fund.

Bean then reported that the State of Illinois replacement taxes have been received.

Trustee Braden made a motion to approve the minutes from the September 23, 2024, regular meeting. Trustee Stover seconded. All present voted in favor. The motion carried.

The Trustees reviewed the budget vs. actual spending/bills.

Following said review Trustee Stover made a motion to approve the audit the Township Road bills. Trustee Braden seconded. All present voted in favor. The motion carried.

Trustee Braden made a motion to approve the Town bills as presented - subject to audit. Trustee Stover seconded. All present voted in favor. The motion carried.

The Clerk attested to all signatures.

Mount Vernon Township road and town levies were presented and discussed.

Road and Bridge proposes a levy of \$639,000.00

Town proposes a levy of \$384,500.00

They will then be finalized and voted on at the November regular meeting.

Highway Commissioner Hayes informed the board that he will be surplus out (sell) a  $\frac{3}{4}$  ton 1999 Dodge Ram pickup truck as he is replacing it with a newer truck he purchased from the State of Illinois surplus lot.

Trustee Braden made a motion to surplus the  $\frac{3}{4}$  ton 1999 Dodge Ram pickup truck. Trustee Stover seconded the motion. All present voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
